KATHARINE BARR HONORARY SCHOLARSHIP WILLIAM BRIDGE SCHOLARSHIP ANN WOOD-KELLY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIREMENTS & CRITERIA

In 2012, three scholarships will be awarded by the Eastern New England Chapter of The Ninety-Nines, Inc. The 99s is an international organization of women pilots, founded in 1929, with Amelia Earhart as its first president. The organization's mission is to promote world fellowship through flight; provide networking and scholarship opportunities for women; and preserve the unique history of women in aviation.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a resident of one of the six New England states (Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Vermont) who is studying anywhere in the U.S. or a resident of any state who is studying in one of the New England states.
- Be at least of high school age and studying in some area of aviation, at a duly accredited school, college flight school, or with a private instructor.
- Submit four complete copies of the five part application attached.

Criteria:

- A combination of academic achievement, high interest and dedication to a career in some area of aviation.
- Involvement in aviation activities, e.g. flying, aviation employment, model airplane building or flying, and science-fair projects.
- Enthusiastic recommendations will be taken into consideration.
- Proof of financial need will be considered.

Other Information:

- The **Katharine Barr Honorary Scholarship** (\$1500) honors one of the long-time members of the Eastern New England Chapter.
- The **William Bridge Scholarship** (\$1500) is funded by Eastern New England Chapter member Anne Bridge Baddour in memory of her father, and awarded to a female with at least a private pilot certificate.
- The **Ann Wood-Kelly Memorial Scholarship** (\$1500) is given in memory of World War II pilot (British Auxiliary Transport Command) and airline executive to a female with at least a private pilot certificate.

Completed applications must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2012.

Section 2: Transcripts

Attach a copy of transcripts of high school and, if applicable, college records. If these are not available, attach a statement of explanation as to why they are not available.

Section3: Financial Statement

Attach a financial statement listing estimated expenses for your planned aviation education or training (tuition, books, room, board, flight training, etc.) Also list your expected sources of income, including anticipated financial aid.

Section 4: Personal Letter

Attach a personal letter describing your reasons for choosing an aviation career. Include descriptions of all your aviation-related activities, emphasizing those that have meant the most to you. Also discuss how you plan to use the scholarship in achieving your goals. What future employment do you plan to pursue?

Section 5: Recommendations

Attach two letters of recommendation from two people who know you well. At least one of them should address your aviation interests and activities.

Application Submission

Submit four copies of your application consisting of the five parts specified above. These must be collated complete copies. Please number the sections. Do not include the cover sheet. It is suggested that these four copies be mailed together with the four copies of the Shirley Mahn Memorial Scholarship application in a Priority Mail envelope.
