We all want our first International election using electronic voting to be a resounding success. That means we need everyone who can to opt in to receive their ballot electronically.

As of today, only 473 out of 5,230 members have opted in. Less than 10% of the membership have indicated this easy, secure and costsaving method of casting their vote.

Anyone who doesn't opt-in for the electronic ballot will be sent a paper ballot at the cost of approximately \$3.00 per ballot for mailing and counting With over 4,700 members getting paper ballots, we would be spending over \$14,000 of the membership dues money for the 2018 election.
