The UMass Transportation Center's Aviation Research and Training Center at Westover Municipal Airport in Chicopee, Massachusetts conducts advanced aeronautical research and provides training for air traffic controllers, pilots, and other aviation professionals. The new center is equipped with a high-fidelity 360-degree air traffic control tower simulator that can be modified for three-dimensional views of a variety of operational environments.

UMassAir complements and leverages the Aviation Research and Training Center at the Westover Metropolitan Airport run by the UMass Transportation Center. As a member of FAA's northeast unmanned aircraft test site, the Aviation Research and Training Center will provide infrastructure and logistical support.
